



Modernization Project for Eastside Memorial ECHS & International / LASA / LBJ ECHS

The 2017 Bond called for several projects that will allow for program expansions and campus modernizations. These include:

- The construction of a new **Eastside Memorial Early College High School/International High School** facility at the original L.C. Anderson site and the restoration of the historic entry at that campus. The estimated cost of the project is \$80 million.
- The move of the **Liberal Arts and Science Academy** to the current Eastside Memorial ECHS/International campus. The Eastside campus also will receive renovation and upgrades for incoming LASA at an estimated cost of \$4 million.
- The renovation of **LBJ Early College High School** for Phase 2 of Career Launch and Phase 1 of the medical program build-out. The estimated cost of the project is \$22 million.
